Title: EMS Congregational Aide

Harrisonburg Mennonite Church participates in the Congregational Student Aid Plan offered and administered by Eastern Mennonite School. This means that HMC will pay 70% of the lowest available tuition fee in Grades 6-12 for those who qualify.

- A family or individual is eligible to participate in the EMS Congregational Aid Plan upon becoming a member of the congregation. Eligibility begins at the start of the new semester following membership. As members, faithful commitment to congregational life is expected, including regular attendance and support of the giving plan. HMC will continue to work with individuals, families, and EMS to accommodate special situations as they arise.
- Any tuition increase for those who apply after the EMS registration deadline is not included in this plan. The Capital Improvement Fee is not included in the Congregational Aid Plan.
- A summary report of each academic year's grants shall be to the Stewardship Chair for review. Should questions arise concerning a family or individual's "Faithful commitment to congregational life," a decision about continuing participation would be made by the Chair of Stewardship, and the Lead Pastor.
